During the meeting, the Foundation Charter was reviewed and signed after the following board trustees and officers were elected:

Chairman – Pierre Akkelian (Canada) Vice-Chairman – Vartkess Knadjian (Switzerland) Treasurer – Gagik Gevorkyan (Russia) Secretary – Aram William Shishmanian (United Kingdom) Trustee – William Edward Boyadjian (USA)

Subsequent meetings were held over the next 2 days between Mr. Akkelian Mr. Knadjian and Mr. Gevorkyan,

during which other AJF related matters were discussed and ideas submitted to create a business plan for the Foundation.



The idea to create an AJA Foundation originally begun in Geneva in 2010. Mr. Akkelian and then president of AJA Mr. Knadjian planned to raise funds to finance a mission to inform the world about the immense contribution that Armenians have made to the art of jewellery making throughout history. Mr. Akkelian and Knadjian also wished to start a scholarship fund to assist talented youth to pursue their studies at the leading design schools of the world in order to perpetuate and maintain

Armenian leadership role in a rapidly changing landscape.
